Note: George Tolhurst's oratorio Ruth was first performed in Prahran, Melbourne in 1864, and repeated in London in 1868. Sarah Kirby has explored contemporary and later reactions to it in her article "'The Worst Oratorio Ever!': Colonialist Condescension in the Critical Reception of George Tolhurst's Ruth (1864)" NineteenthCentury Music Review, 2017, 1-29. This attempt at a modern performing version of one of its most celebrated choruses (the fifth movement of Part II of the oratorio) presents the accompaniment in an arrangement for piano duet. The source is the 1868 vocal score, the only one known for much of the work - the full orchestral score is lost. I have tacitly amended a few minor inconsistencies in note lengths and dynamic indications; passages in small notes and dynamics in square brackets are my additions.
Similar arrangements are available of other movements in the oratorio. I would be pleased to hear of performances of any part of Ruth in this or any other version.
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
