

## Psalm 118:1-2,14-24 - *Confitemini Domino*

*Antiphon* (initially twice, choir/cantor then repeated by all; thereafter, once only by all)

14 The LORD is my strength and my song, and  
he has be - come my sal - va - - - tion.

### *Verses*

- 1 Give thanks to the LORD, for he is good; \*  
his mercy endures for ever.
- 2 Let Israel now proclaim, \*  
"His mercy endures for ever." (*Antiphon*)
- 15 There is a sound of exultation and victory \*  
in the tents of the righteous:
- 16 "The right hand of the LORD has triumphed! \*  
the right hand of the LORD is exalted!  
the right hand of the LORD has triumphed!" (*Antiphon*)
- 17 I shall not die, but live, \*  
and declare the works of the LORD.
- 18 The LORD has punished me sorely, \*  
but he did not hand me over to death. (*Antiphon*)
- 19 Open [for me] the gates of righteousness; \*  
I will enter them; I will offer thanks to the LORD.
- 20 "This is the gate of the LORD; \*  
he who is righteous may enter." (*Antiphon*)
- 21 I will give thanks to you, for you answered me \*  
and have become my salvation.
- 22 The same stone which the builders rejected \*  
has become the chief cornerstone. (*Antiphon*)
- 23 This is the LORD's doing, \*  
and it is marvelous in our eyes.
- 24 On this day the LORD has acted; \*  
we will rejoice and be glad in it. (*Antiphon*)
